



THE GEORGE Aim1: Landscape review of respite care funding

- Medicaid
- Medicare, Medicare Advantage & Special Needs Plans
- Veteran's Administration
- Potential alternative respite care funding mechanisms



What did we find?

- I. Funding is available for diverse tasks
 - Respite program creation, volunteer engagement, and care episode reimbursement
- II. Medicaid: main state funding mechanism for respite care
 - New York State 1915 Medicaid waiver
 - PACE program
 - State Respite Care program
- III. Medicare Advantage and Special Needs plans <u>can</u> cover respite care
- IV. Funding mechanism suitability depends on:
 - Grantees' specific needs
 - Population mix served
