# **Instructions**

The Blair Family AvalonBay College Scholarship seeks to make a lasting difference in the lives of individuals who would benefit greatly from a challenging college education that may lie beyond reach financially. It aims to support the educational aspirations of highly motivated and talented children of full-time AvalonBay associates who are preparing for college.

The Blair Family AvalonBay College Scholarship offers up to \$25,000 per year to children of full-time AvalonBay associates who excel academically, are actively engaged in extracurricular and/or community activities, and have substantial financial need. Scholarships are renewable for up to four years, provided the student remains in good academic standing. Scholarship amounts will be determined based on financial need and the financial aid package awarded by the institution the student plans to attend.

When filling out your application, read all questions and instructions carefully.

#### Completing your application

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- To preview the application, click on the **Print Questions** button in the upper right-hand corner. You should do this prior to beginning the application to review the questions.
- To complete all required forms, download and save them to your desktop. Fill out the forms and save the completed version to your computer before uploading them to the application.
- Click the Save as Draft button at the bottom of the page to save your responses. To
  return to your application on a later date, log in and click on your application under your
  contact information. It will be marked Draft until you submit it.
- Questions marked with an asterisk (\*) are required. You will not be able to submit your application until all required questions are answered.
- Recommender must upload a letter of recommendation to the student's online application.
- SAT and/or ACT Test Scores: Submitting test scores this year is optional. Test scores can be included in the application and a copy of scores need to be uploaded to the application, if you choose to include your scores.

#### Submitting your application:

• You must submit your application for it to be considered. Once you submit your application, you will receive an email confirming its receipt. If you do not receive this email, then it has not been properly submitted and will not be reviewed. Log back into your account to submit, or email AVBscholarship@tpi.org.

- Note: Your recommenders will continue to have access to submit their materials even after you click "submit." You do not need to wait for your recommendations to be complete in order to submit your application.
- Before Clicking Submit: Make sure all attachments are uploaded in .pdf, .doc, or .docx format, and your answers are complete and clear. Click on the "Application Packet" button to view your application in the form the reviewers will see it. Applications that have blank, unreadable attachments, or don't load correctly will not be considered. It is important that you look over your application to make sure everything has been properly submitted.
