ABOUT

The Harrison Scholarship aims to make college affordable for students who receive Catholic Schools Foundation (CSF) scholarship support and help them reach their full potential. The program is funded by an anonymous donor and administered by The Philanthropic Initiative (TPI).

THE AWARD

- Four-year, renewable scholarship to cover tuition, fees and educational expenses at a four-year college/university in the U.S., provided requirements are met.
- Scholarship amounts will be determined based on the financial aid award package the student receives from the college they choose to attend. Scholarships will likely range from \$5,000 to \$15,000 per year.
- Flexible funding available to support student's enrichment costs.

	Permanent resident of Massachusetts.
Financial Circumstances	 Senior or recent high school graduate who is currently receiving/received Catholic Schools Foundation (CSF) scholarship support.
	 Adjusted Gross Family Income (AGI) of \$100,000 or less. Unmet financial need of at least \$5,000 beyond what is being offered in college financial aid and other scholarships, as determined by college financial aid award letter and after considering the student's expected family contribution
Academic	 Enrolling as a first-year student in a four-year degree program, at a US accredited, not-for-profit, private or public college or university full-time in 2025-26. Strong academic record in high school.
	 Students interested in renewing their award must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above.
Personal	Involved in a balance of community, school, and work activities.
	Motivated to excel in college.

Complete applications are **due Wednesday, February 26, 2025, by 11:59 PM**. Only complete applications submitted online will be reviewed. Please follow instructions carefully.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The following materials are required. Only complete applications submitted online will be considered.

- 1. Application Submitted Online
- 2. Extracurricular Information or Resume
- **3.** Letter of Recommendation (from a teacher, guidance counselor, work supervisor, community leader, coach, or any other non-family member who knows the student well)
- **4.** Essay A writing sample that reflects the student's personal history and aspirations for the future (e.g. college application essays or personal statement)
- 5. High school transcript
- 6. FAFSA Submission Summary

TIMELINE

- Application deadline is February 26, 2025 by 11:59pm.
- Selected applicants will be invited for interviews in April.
- Scholarship recipients and amounts will be announced in late April.
- If awarded, scholarships will be sent directly to colleges by the end of July.
