Who is seeing and experiencing your work both in live and online performances? How do they learn about your work? As COVID led to many performances being presented online, did you reach new audiences with digital work? If yes, are your online audiences composed of different demographics than your live performances? Has your balance of online and in-person performances shifted? What are your plans for building new audiences? We recognize that some work is best suited for live and other work on film. Is there an additional audience you would like to engage, and how do you plan to reach them? Be specific.

Submit two video files of work created between September 2022–October 2025: TOTAL TIME 10 MINUTES. YOU MUST SUBMIT AT LEAST 5 MINUTES OF YOUR WORK OR YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE COMPETITIVE.

A minimum of 5 minutes will be viewed. If submitting two samples from the same longer work, make it very clear which is to be viewed first.

Provide cue time(s) for the sections of video you would like the panel to view. Work samples without such annotations will be viewed from the beginning through the first 5 minutes.

Highly-edited works with multiple cuts, camera angles, etc., such as those created especially for television, commercial distribution, or theatrical exhibition, are discouraged EXCEPT where the applicant's project plan includes a proposal to work specifically in dance media/cinema, e.g., dance for the camera.
